

CERRO VILLA UNIFORM POLICY 2024-2025

Cerro Villa Middle School has a student uniform policy in place.

Shirts: Students must wear a Cerro Villa Middle School polo shirt. CV Polos may be a variety of colors; white, blue, green, maroon, gray, or black. CVMS club and spirit shirts, college/military shirts, and Villa Park High School shirts are allowed in lieu of the polo shirt.

Pants: Uniform pants, skirts, and shorts may be denim, khaki, blue, navy, or black with no holes or tears and must be worn at the natural waistline. Pants, shorts, or skirts which allow undergarments to show are not allowed. No sagging of bottoms. Uniform bottoms can be purchased at many general retail stores or from our uniform vendor.

Shoes: Students will wear closed toe athletic shoes or low-cut leather shoes.. Crocs are allowed on campus but may not be worn in Physical Education class.

Hats: Cerro Villa or Villa Park High School hats are allowed.

Outerwear: School appropriate sweatshirts are allowed. Cerro Villa polos or spirit shirts must be worn under the sweatshirts and hoods to remain off in class at all times.

Clothing NOT ALLOWED:

- Pro Club Gear clothing
- Biker (spandex) shorts or Volleyball shorts
- Oversized or undersized shirts, tank tops, midriiffs, or sleeveless shirts.
- Sleepwear and loungewear (*sponsored "pajama day" is exception*)
- Non CV or VP Hats.
- Beanies
- No steel-toed shoes, slippers or flip-flops

Clothing or accessories considered to have group or gang identification symbols as determined by the Orange County Sheriff and the Orange County Police department are not allowed. Also prohibited are clothes or accessories which contain offensive or obscene symbols (depictions of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, vulgar language, or sexual activity). Shirts with signs, slogans or words that degrade gender, cultural, religious or ethnic value are also not allowed.

Cerro Villa FREE DRESS Days:

- o "Free dress" days are offered throughout the school year, are considered privileges, and should not be a distraction to the school day.
- o Shirts should cover the shoulders and stomach. (No tank tops, crop tops or sleeveless tops).
- o Jeans/bottoms should not be ripped or have holes. (No sleepwear at any time.)
- o No inappropriate language or logos
- o When in doubt, do not wear it!

If you are OUT of dress code, you will be sent to the office to change. For every offense a consequence will be assigned. Parents/guardians will be notified to bring a uniform for the student.
